Papers should fulfill the following criteria:

- Prepared for blind review
- No more than 4,000 words
- Suitable for 25-minute presentation
- Preceded by an abstract of 150-250 words

Along with the paper, please also submit a cover page with the following information:

- Presenter's name
- Institutional affiliation
- Contact information (email address or phone number)
- Title of paper
- Abstract of the paper
- Word count

The deadline for submissions is July 29. We will notify those whose papers have been accepted no later than August 29.
