Essay topics in all areas of ethical theory and political philosophy will be considered, although some priority will be given to essays that take up themes from the work of Michelle Moody-Adams and Arthur Ripstein: democracy, equality, ethics of war, freedom, hope, justice, Kant's political philosophy, liberalism, moral psychology, and philosophy of law. Essays should be prepared for blind review in word, rtf, or pdf format.
