Submissions should be suitable for a 25 minute presentation (i.e., should not exceed 4000 words, or 10-12 pages).

Papers must be prepared for blind review and should include, on a separate cover sheet, the following information: paper title, author's name, institutional affiliation, address/e-mail address, word count, and a short abstract.
