General Information:

The conference will be divided into sessions lasting approximately one hour. Each session will consist of a 25 minute presentation of the accepted paper, followed by a prepared commentary lasting approximately ten to fifteen minutes, followed by approximately twenty minutes of general discussion. Each paper should be no longer than 5000 words. Quality papers in any area of philosophy are welcome. (We especially welcome topics in metaphysics, epistemology, language, value theory and the history and philosophy of science.)

Submission Requirements:

Submissions should be prepared for blind review (no identifiable information within the text), and should include a *separate cover-page* with the following information:

- *Full name*
- *Title*
- *Abstract (300 words or less)*
- *Institution*
- *Word count (5000 word maximum)*
- *Contact Information (E-mail and phone number)*
- *An indication of whether you would like to comment on a paper and in what areas of philosophy you are most competent to do so.*
