PAMBA PRIZE

We are also pleased to invite submissions for the PAMBA Prize essay in any area of the philosophy of animal minds. The winning essay will be published in *Biology & Philosophy* and the winner will be awarded an invitation to present the paper as a keynote talk at the PAMBA meeting in Santa Barbara, including a cash prize of \$3000 CAD to offset travel costs. The paper must be under 10,000 words and meet the *Biology & Philosophy* submission guidelines.

The competition is open to early-career researchers, defined as PhD students or those who are within five years of receiving their PhDs (i.e., the PhD should have been received in January 2020 or later).

Submissions on all aspects of the philosophy of animal minds are welcome.
