### **CONFERENCE & SUBMISSION INFORMATION**

The Philosophy Graduate Student Association at the University of Georgia is pleased to announce the second Student Philosophy in the South conference, which will take place in person on the University of Georgia campus. We invite paper submissions from current graduate students in philosophy working in any area or tradition within the discipline. This conference aims to promote community and collaboration amongst graduate students.

Each presenter will receive two sets of comments, one from a graduate student and one from an advanced undergraduate student. Undergraduate students will be paired with a graduate student mentor.

Each author may submit only one paper for consideration. We especially encourage submissions from members of traditionally underrepresented groups in philosophy. Papers submitted for consideration should meet the following guidelines:

- I. Be no more than 3000 words in length (excluding references),**
- II. Begin with a title and an abstract (not to exceed 150 words).**
- III. Be prepared for blind review.**
- IV. Be accompanied by a separate document including the title and abstract, author's name, institutional affiliation, year and program, and contact information.**

Submissions must be received by August 10, 2026, and be sent to spitsconference@gmail.com with "SPITS 2026" and the author's name in the subject line. Responses will be sent via email by 19 August 2026.
