Submissions must include an anonymized abstract of about 500 words in .pdf or .doc format, with a view to present for 20 minutes followed by a 10-minute Q&A.

- Current level of graduate studies
- SPEL (Social, Political, Ethical, Legal) themes relevant to your paper
- Your abstract prepared for anonymous review
