Presenters should be prepared to obtain their own funding, though we will be able to award two bursaries of 200€ each to help with costs associated with presenting at the workshop (and can include childcare or other accessibility related costs). If you would like to be considered for one of these bursaries, please include a brief letter with your submission that outlines your needs. These bursaries are generously supported by the University of Hamburg's Frauenförderfonds.

While not required, we highly recommend pre-distribution of papers, slides, or other presentation material.
