CALL FOR PAPERS

Some of the most ground-breaking inventions in contemporary philosophy have come from feminist philosophy. However, the transformative potential of feminist philosophy for renewing the discipline in terms of canon, concepts, histories, institutional cultures, and plurality of styles has not yet been actualized. The feminist utopias envisioned by feminist philosophers across traditional philosophical divides and cultures possess the potential for invigorating philosophy.

The first day will be spent at the University of Iceland in Reykjavík where we will listen to keynote speakers in an open conference. In the evening we leave for Skálholt outside Reykjavík for a three-day workshop with 30 minute paper presentations and discussion sessions.
