Travel to the University of Lodz Conference Centre (Lodz, Kopcinskiego 16/18)

From Warsaw Chopin Airport

The easiest way to travel from Warsaw Chopin Airport to Lodz is by train from the Warsaw Central Station. For transfer directions to the station please see:

The recommended public transfer options are the **airport train** or the **175 bus**. Once you reach Warsaw Central Station (*Warszawa Centralna*), please purchase the fare for a train of your choice to **Lodz Kaliska** (the name of your destination). As there are two companies which service this route, it is best to buy your ticket on arrival, when you know which train you will take. The trains to Lodz depart approximately every hour. Tickets can be bought at the offices which are situated in the main hall as well as in the underground section.

To get from the **Lodz Kaliska** station to conference site (*Kopcinskiego 16/18*) you can either take a taxi (for ca 25 PLN) or **the 12** tram (direction **Stoki**). The journey by tram takes ca 20-25 minutes, which means that you should purchase a 40-minute tram fare (for 3.40 PLN) at a newsstand. The destination stop, called *Kopcinskiego* is about 100 meters away from the Conference Centre.

From Lodz Reymont Airport

There is no direct public transport connection with the University Conference Centre. You can either take **a taxi** (for ca 30 PLN) or the **65 bus** which will take you (in ca 15 minutes) near the **Lodz Kaliska** railway station (the stop is called *Lodz Kaliska-Estakada*) from where you have to take a short walk to the **12 tram.** The tram will take you to the Conference Centre (see the directions above).

Due to the necessity of transfer we recommend a taxi if you land at this airport.
