Please send an abstract of the paper (750 word limit) as an email (".doc") attachment. Abstracts should be formatted for anonymous review and submitted to the program committee chair, Cassie Striblen (**CStriblen@wcupa.edu**), on or before **January 15, 2013**. Please indicate "Arendt Circle submission" in the subject heading of your email message.
