WE ASK THAT APPLICANTS SUBMIT A 500-WORD INFORMATIVE ABSTRACT\* WITH NAME AND AFFILIATED INSTITUTION. \*All abstracts must have a coherent thesis & supporting argument.

BEING AN INFORMATIVE ABSTRACT, WE HAVE CITED THE UNC CHAPEL HILL GUIDELINES, AS THEY ACCURATELY DESCRIBE ITS PURPOSE: "THE MAJORITY OF ABSTRACTS ARE INFORMATIVE. WHILE THEY STILL DO NOT CRITIQUE OR EVALUATE A WORK, THEY DO MORE THAN DESCRIBE IT. A GOOD INFORMATIVE ABSTRACT ACTS AS A SURROGATE FOR THE WORK ITSELF. THAT IS, THE WRITER PRESENTS AND EXPLAINS ALL THE MAIN ARGUMENTS AND THE IMPORTANT RESULTS AND EVIDENCE IN THE COMPLETE ARTICLE/PAPER/BOOK. AN INFORMATIVE ABSTRACT INCLUDES THE INFORMATION THAT CAN BE FOUND IN A DESCRIPTIVE ABSTRACT (PURPOSE, METHODS, SCOPE) BUT ALSO INCLUDES THE RESULTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF THE RESEARCH AND THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE AUTHOR."
