Only papers written by undergraduate students will be accepted. <u>Submission deadline is February 18, 2018</u>. All papers are subject to blind review. Include detachable title page with name, title, and institution. The paper itself should include the paper title and a short abstract but no name or name of institution. Papers should be prepared to be read within 30-40 minutes. Each paper will be assigned a student commentator.
