

Ki (氣) as a Phenomenology of Feeling

The speaker will introduce a part of the main thesis in her doctoral project. The focus of her dissertation is to point out a possible connection between current debates in the philosophy of feelings (or what is called “Philosophie der Gefühle” in Germany) and the concept of *Ki* (*Qi*), a Sino-Japanese term for breath, sense, feeling, atmosphere, mood, smell, intention, etc. The concept of *Ki* has a broad and flexible range of meanings, including its transformative character between materiality and immateriality.
