<u>Graduate Student and Faculty Submissions</u>: Please email an abstract of no more than 550 words in a file prepared for blind review, meaning without any personal identifying information. In the body of the e-mail include author's name, paper title, institutional affiliation, faculty or graduate student status, address, phone number, and email address. Final papers should be of a length that permits a 20-25 minute presentation.

<u>Undergraduate Student Submissions</u>: Please submit a paper, formatted with double-spaced, numbered pages, 3000 words maximum (not counting notes) in a file prepared for blind review as described above. Include in a separate file an abstract of no more than 250 words. In the body of the e-mail include author's name, paper title, institutional affiliation, address, phone number, and word count for the paper. Time for presentation will be 15 to 20 minutes.
