PAPERS MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, JANUARY 11th, 2019!

Students who have submitted a paper shall receive a notification of acceptance by Friday, February 8th, 2019.

A small stipend may be awarded to presenters to reduce the cost of travel.
