- Authors must be current graduate students in philosophy. Co-authored papers are permitted if all authors are currently graduate students.
- Responses to submissions will be sent no later than 8th March.
- If your submission is successful, we will require a draft paper of no more than 2,500 words, for a 20-25 minute presentation to be received by email no later than 15th April.
- Upon presentation, your paper may be subsequently reviewed for possible inclusion in our Graduate Journal *Perspectives*.
