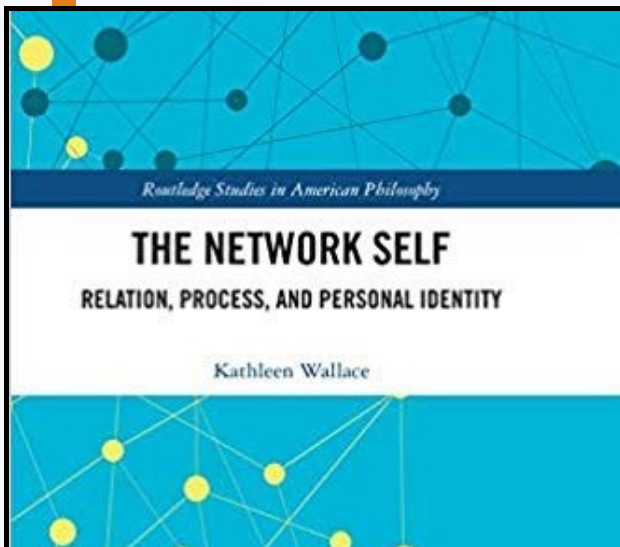


**THE NETWORK SELF:
