- Manuscript must be submitted in a Word Document, be double-spaced with a 12-point font, have page numbers, and 1-inch margins.
- The manuscript must be formatted in the Chicago Manual of Style.
- Must include separate attachment for figures.
- Must include separate abstract that is no longer than 300 words.
- Submissions should be between 3000 to 4500 words and prepared for blind review.
- Author must remove name and institutional affiliation from all documents.

Submission Requirements for Book

Reviews

- Auslegung publishes book reviews that touch on philosophical-issues. We are open to publishing book reviews of books that are not philosophical, but we encourage that reviews bring philosophical issues to bear in the review.Unlike original research articles and commentaries, there is no need to submit an abstract.
- Book reviews should not exceed 600 words, should be submitted in a Word Document with a 12-point font, double-spaced, and should be formatted using the Chicago Manual of Style.
