Submission Guidelines:

- Papers can be on any philosophical topic
- 5-10 pages not including bibliography
- Include an abstract of 100-200 words
- Prepared for **anonymous**-reviewing (don't include your name on paper or abstract)
- Send as an attachment (.doc or .pdf) to Bailie Peterson at bailie.peterson@unco.edu

In the body of the email, please include:

- 1. Paper Title
- 2. Author's name
- 3. Institutional affiliation
- 4. Email address
- 5. Telephone number
- 6. If you are a first-generation student
- 7. Preference regarding commentary
- 8. Interest in Panel Presentation

Each paper will have a commentator. Anyone interested in providing comments should state their interest. Include if you would like to be a commentator if your paper is not accepted. If you would like to be considered as a panel presenter, please note this, and briefly explain your goals in doing so.

Papers that do not include the above will not be considered. No more than one paper by the same author will be considered. Papers will be reviewed by the conference planning committee. Notifications will be made via email by February 28th, 2020. Submissions whose authors cannot be contacted will be rejected.
