- All submissions must be prepared for blind review. The paper must have no identifying information and must include at the top an abstract of no more than 250 words.
- Submitted papers must be no more than 4500 words in length.
- Submitted papers must be received as .doc, .docx, or .pdf files no later than **January 7th 2013.**
- Accepted papers will be announced at the beginning of February 2013.
