Citation style should follow the *Chicago Manual of Style* with short-title citations in the footnotes and a list of references at the end of the article. Accepted papers may be posted in final format on Online First by the Philosophy Documentation Center. We especially welcome submissions representing radical perspectives from under-represented and/or marginalized groups.
