Budget Accommodations for Loyola-Marquette Phenomenology Conference "Phenomenology and Critique"

Hotels

Because of a Loyola Admissions office event, the Hampton Inn across the street from LUC is very expensive the weekend of the conference. Here are some budget options. These are just suggestions based on what is available, pricing, location to LUC and customer reviews:

<u>Heart O' Chicago Motel</u> (5990 North Ridge Ave. Chicago)— an older classic motel that has positive ratings for what it is and great prices. Only 1+ miles from campus.

<u>Claridge House</u> (1301 N State Parkway, Chicago)— a higher end hotel in the Gold Coast with some cheaper rooms (just under \$500 for 2 nights). Hotel has very good rating on Expedia

<u>Hampton Inn Rosemont-O'Hare</u> (9480 Higgins Rd., Rosemont)— (about a 30-minute drive), good price, very good reviews, the downside is the drive

<u>Baymont Glenview</u> (1625 Milwaukee Ave., Glenmont) (about a 30-minute drive)— Very good prices and good reviews too; located in north-west suburbs of LUC campus.

Airbnb

Here are some Airbnb options. Some are better for a group of 2, others for groups of 3-5. It seems like there are some nice Airbnb options in the area near Loyola:

4-bed/1 Bath very close to campus with good ratings: ideal for 4+ people

<u>1bed plus sofa</u> with great location very close to campus

New Airbnb for 2-4 guests, just north of campus. Looks nice, but only one rating
